## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 79-23

PROPOSED-AUTHORIZATION TO NEGOTIATE WITH THE U.S. GEOLOGICAL SURVEY FOR A GROUNDWATER INVESTIGATION IN THE SANTA YNEZ VALLEY AND APPROVAL TO AMEND THE STATE BOARD'S MASTER AGREEMENT WITH THE USGS TO INCLUDE THE SUBJECT STUDY

## WHEREAS:

- Communities in the Santa Ynez Valley rely on groundwater for water supply;
- Urban and agricultural activities are affecting the quality of such groundwater;
- 3. The Central Coast Regional Board has proposed a three-year \$160,000 cooperative investigation with the U.S. Geological Survey to investigate groundwater quality and quantity in the Santa Ynez Valley; and
- 4. Information generated in the study will be used by the Regional Board in evaluating impacts of wastewater discharges, increased water extractions, and alternative water resources management strategies.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board authorizes the Executive Director to negotiate a cooperative study with the U.S. Geological Survey and authorizes funding of \$30,000 for the first year of this three-year investigation of groundwater in the Santa Ynez Valley, subject to funding by the USGS of \$30,000 in matching funds. Continuation of the study, after the first year, will depend on the first year's results and the availability of funds.
