STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 79- 25

AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT TO USGS CONTRACT FOR MONITORING OF NEW AND ALAMO RIVERS COACHELLA VALLEY GROUNDWATER, AND COLO-RADO RIVER SALINITY

WHEREAS:

- 1. The New River continues to be a major unresolved water pollution problem;
- 2. Coachella Valley groundwaters are being recharged with higher TDS Colorado River water;
- 3. California is committed to developing salinity control measures for discharge to the Colorado River from California; and
- 4. Water quality monitoring is necessary to continue to document such water quality problems and assess the effectiveness of control measures.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board authorizes the Executive Director to execute an amendment to Cooperative Agreement No. W6-145-40 with the U.S. Geological Survey to extend the completion date until June 30, 1979, at a cost not to exceed \$45,000.
