BOARD ACCEPTANCE OF FINAL REPORT "ASSESSMENT
OF WATER QUALITY IMPACTS: ALTERNATIVES FOR
DISCHARGE OF SAN JOAQUIN VALLEY AGRICULTURAL
DRAINAGE TO THE WESTERN DELTA-SUISUN BAY
REGION", PREPARED BY HYDROSCIENCE, INC.
(STANDARD AGREEMENT NO. 7 167 40-8)

WHEREAS:


1. The Board is participating with the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation and the Department of Water Resources in the San Joaquin Valley Interagency Drainage Program.
2. The Board's responsibility in this program is to prepare an environmental assessment of various agricultural drainage management and disposal options and an environmental impact report of the recommended program.
3. The Board contracted with Hydroscience, Inc., to perform mathematical modeling of selected agricultural drainage management and disposal options.
4. Hydroscience has completed its work in substantial fulfillment of its contractual obligation with the Board.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board accepts the final report "Assessment of Water Quality Impacts: Alternatives for Discharge of San Joaquin Valley Agricultural Drainage to the Western Delta-Suisun Bay Region", in fulfillment of Standard Agreement No. 7 167 40-8.
