- The Board is participating with the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation and the Department of Water Resources in the San Joaquin Valley Interagency Drainage Program.
- 2. The Board's responsibility in this program is to prepare an environmental assessment of various agricultural drainage management and disposal options and an environmental impact report of the recommended program.
- 3. The Board contracted with Hydroscience, Inc., to perform mathematical modeling of selected agricultural drainage management and disposal options.
- 4. Hydroscience has completed its work in substantial fulfillment of its contractual obligation with the Board.

That the Board accepts the final report "Assessment of Water Quality Impacts: Alternatives for Discharge of San Joaquin Valley Agricultural Drainage to the Western Delta-Suisun Bay Region", in fulfillment of Standard Agreement No. 7 167 40-8.
