STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 79-39

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES FOR SPECIAL WATER QUALITY MONITORING STUDIES

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Board desires to continue a special water quality monitoring program through agreement with a state agency.
- 2. The special water quality monitoring program is to include surveys of selected lakes, monitoring of selected groundwater basins, and conduct of intensive surveys.
- 3. The Department of Water Resources has the staff and technical capability to provide the specified services and desires to provide such services to the State Board.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board's Chief, Division of Planning and Research, be authorized to negotiate and execute an Interagency Agreement with the Department of Water Resources for special water quality monitoring studies for an amount not to exceed \$96,000 in F. Y. 1979-80 Bond Fund monies, subject to availability of funds, for the period ending June 30, 1980.
