STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 79-53

SUPPORTING THE PLAN ADOPTED BY THE AIR RESOURCES BOARD TO MEET AIR QUALITY STANDARDS AT LAKE TAHOE

WHEREAS:

- On May 9, 1979, the State Air Resources Board adopted a Lake Tahoe Plan, a revision to the State Implementation Plan, to meet federal air quality standards.
- 2. Implementation of the Plan will also protect water quality.
- 3. The Plan calls for road use charges which will help raise funds for erosion control.
- 4. The Plan also calls for snow removal practices which will reduce siltation from roads.
- 5. The Plan also calls for a subdivision moratorium, which will prevent increased erosion and surface runoff which might result from subdivision construction.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. The State Water Resources Control Board supports implementation of the Lake Tahoe Plan adopted by the Air Resources Board.
- 2. The State Board urges the United States Environmental Protection Agency to promptly approve the Plan, including those measures in the Plan which will help protect water quality.
- 3. The State Board urges the United States Environmental Protection Agency to take all action within its power to ensure that the Plan is implemented.
- 4. The State Board calls upon all other state and federal agencies to support and help implement the Plan.
