STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 79-60

SUBMITTAL OF WORKPLANS TO EPA FOR PHASE II 208 PLANNING

WHEREAS:

- 1. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has identified \$3,857,000 as being available to the State for nondesignated area planning.
- 2. Workplans have been drafted which describe such planning to be conducted.
- 3. In designated areas, the State and Regional Boards maintain a separate regulatory planning program for the development of water quality standards and the implementation of water quality plans.
- 4. Workplans have been drafted which identify such regulatory planning to be conducted by the State and Regional Boards in designated areas requiring a total funding of \$1,274,087.
- 5. It is the intent of the Board to work with EPA in the review of each workplan issue and to make revisions where appropriate.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

- Conditionally approves the workplans for regulatory planning in designated and nondesignated areas of the State.
- 2. Authorizes the Executive Director to submit the workplans to EPA and to notify EPA that the State, after the review of federal funding, will conduct regulatory planning in designated areas as identified in the workplans and in conformance with 40 CFR, 35.1521-4 (c) (3).
- Will make appropriate amendments to the workplans and submit these to EPA no later than September 20, 1979.
- 4. Authorizes the Executive Director to submit the workplan and an application to EPA for a 208 planning grant to negotiate with EPA, as appropriate.
