STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 79-61

REVIEW OF SAN DIEGO REGIONAL BOARD ORDER NO. 79-35 WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR LEUCADIA COUNTY WATER DISTRICT WATER RECLAMATION PLANT.

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Leucadia County Water District proposes to reactivate its existing Forest Gafner Water Reclamation Plant to provide reclaimed wastewater for the La Costa Golf Course near the City of Carlsbad, San Diego County.
- 2. On May 21, 1979, the San Diego Regional Board adopted Order No. 79-35, waste discharge requirements for the Leucadia County Water District's Reclamation Plant.
- 3. On June 29, 1979, the Rancho La Costa Residents' Association filed a late petition for review of Order No. 79-35.
- 4. Considerable citizen concern has been expressed in opposition to and in favor of this project.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board will expeditiously review on its own motion the appropriateness of Order No. 79-35. It is the intent of the Board to adopt an order in this matter within 60 days if the Leucadia County Water District and the Rancho La Costa Residents' Association waive by July 26, 1979, the applicability of the regulations pertaining to the time provided for filing responses contained in Subchapter 6, Chapter 3, Title 23, California Administrative Code. If said waivers are obtained, all interested persons shall submit comments in this matter by July 26, 1979. If said waivers are not obtained, it is the intent of the Board to adopt an order within 90 days.
