# STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 79-63

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT WITH SRI INTERNATIONAL FOR IDENTIFICATION OF CHEMICAL MUTAGENS IN WASTEWATER

### WHEREAS:

- 1. Studies funded by the State Board have shown that the Ames mutagenicity test can be used successfully on wastewaters to estimate mutagenic potential.
- 2. The same studies have also shown that mutagenic compounds do occur in California wastewaters.
- 3. Mutagenicity is strongly correlated to cancer-causing potential and is therefore important in assessing wastewater disposal options.
- 4. Control of these compounds is dependent on identification of their chemical composition and source.
- 5. The State Board issued a request for proposals and received proposals from James Montgomery Engineers and SRI International.
- 6. The staff panel reviewing the proposals has recommended that SRI International be awarded the contract.

# THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Executive Director be authorized to negotiate and execute a contract with SRI International for identification of chemical mutagens in wastewater for a duration of 12 months in an amount not to exceed \$82,000.
