STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 79-66

APPEAL BY MS. AGNES D. LIVELY FROM STAFF DETERMINATION OF INELIGIBILITY FOR GRADE IV CERTIFICATION AND REQUEST FOR A HEARING

WHEREAS:

- 1. An application for the Grade IV wastewater treatment plant operator certification examination was submitted on January 9, 1979, by Agnes D. Lively.
- 2. By a letter dated February 5, 1979, Ms. Lively was notified of a staff determination denying her application for the Grade IV examination on the ground that she failed to meet the experience and education requirements for certification at this level.
- 3. Ms. Lively appealed the staff determination and requested a hearing before the Board, by a letter dated February 28, 1979.
- 4. Applicant was requested to submit (to the Board) any additional evidence which she had concerning her claim, and, in response, applicant sent a letter dated April 3, 1979.
- 5. Staff has thoroughly reviewed applicant's letter and her file and has concluded that Ms. Lively fails to meet the experience and educational requirements for Grade IV certification, as specified in 23 C.A.C. §2480(d).
- 6. The Board has also reviewed the record in this case.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That on the basis of the record before the Board, the staff determination is affirmed, and Ms. Lively's request for a hearing is denied.
