## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 79-72

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT FOR A STUDY OF "OZONE TREATMENT OF WASTEWATER USED IN COOLING TOWERS"

## WHEREAS:

- 1. Need exists to develop less costly methods to pretreat and condition water for industrial water recycling.
- 2. Recent study showed ozonation was effective in preventing biological fouling and permitted operation of cooling waters at very high cycles of concentration.
- 3. Brown and Caldwell Consulting Engineers propose to further study and evaluate ozone treatment a possible economic way to pretreat and condition water for industrial water recycling.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Executive Director be authorized to negotiate and execute a contract for a study of "Ozone Treatment of Wastewater Used in Cooling Towers" not to exceed \$98,523.
