RESOLUTION NO. 79- 73

ADOPTING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA
AND U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY, REGION IX,
ON THE DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF AN
INTEGRATED TOXICS MANAGEMENT PROGRAM FOR
STATE FISCAL YEAR 1979-80
FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 1980

WHEREAS:


1. The control of toxic substances is a major concern in California today;
2. It is the goal of EPA and the State to ensure that the programs relating to toxics management are implemented in an integrated, cost-effective and coordinated manner;
3. The Agreement assesses the toxic problem and identifies several environmental issues which cross agency- and program-specific boundaries; and
4. The Agreement identifies Agency-specific actions to be taken for an integrated toxics management program.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the State Board approves the Interagency State/EPA Agreement on Toxics Management which includes specific actions to be taken by the SWRCB and the Regional Boards;
2. That the State Board authorizes the Chairman to sign the Agreement;
3. That the Executive Director of the State Board and Executive Officers of the Regional Water Quality Control Boards are directed to implement the course of action outlined in the Agreement.
