STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 79-76

ADOPTING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

AND THE U. S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY, REGION IX,

ON THE DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CALIFORNIA

STATE WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PROGRAM FOR

STATE FISCAL YEAR 1979-80

FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR - 1980

WHEREAS:

- Chapter I of the Agreement constitutes the annual Water Quality Assessment describing current water quality conditions and trends and identifying existing and potential water quality problems in California;
- 2) Chapter II of the Agreement constitutes a multi-year State Strategy and is a statement to the people of California on the major directions of the State's water quality management program;
- Chapter III of the Agreement reflects appropriate coordination activities among Federal, State, Regional, and local agencies;
- 4) Chapter IV of the Agreement constitutes the annual Program Description and identifies the resources needed and the origin of the resources to implement the State's water quality program management for the fiscal year 1979-80; and
- 5) Chapter V of the Agreement meets the Federal requirements for establishing a negotiation process to insure the satisfactory resolve of issues, identifies issues resolved, and schedules the development of the Federal fiscal year 1981 Agreement.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1) That the State Board approves the Agreement which includes the State Strategy and the Program Description for FY 1980;
- 2) That the State Board authorizes the Chairman to sign the Agreement;
- 3) That the Executive Director of the State Board and Executive Officers of the Regional Water Quality Control Boards are directed to implement the course of action outlined in the State Strategy.
