STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 79-78

APPROVAL OF WORKPLAN FOR PHASE II 208 PLANNING

WHEREAS:

- 1. The U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has identified \$2,916,750 as being available to the State for water quality management planning.
- 2. The State Board, in June 1979, submitted to EPA an initial 208 workplan while indicating an intent to make appropriate amendments to the workplan and submit these by September 20, 1979.
- 3. A final nondesignated area workplan has been prepared which describes the planning to be conducted which includes the State's \$972,250 matching funds.
- 4. The Board received public testimony on the workplan at a hearing held on September 11, 1979.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

- 1. Approve the workplan for water quality management planning; and
- 2. Authorize the Executive Director to submit the workplan to EPA for approval.
