STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 79-79

REQUEST BY CONTRA COSTA COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT NO. 7-A FOR WAIVER FROM 30-DAY TIME LIMIT FOR APPEAL TO STATE BOARD

WHEREAS:

- 1. By a letter dated July 28, 1978, the Division of Water Quality notified Contra Costa County Sanitation District No. 7-A of its final decision regarding the sizing of certain sludge processing facilities for the District's treatment plant, Project No. C-06-1002.
- 2. The District failed to appeal this decision to the State Board within 30 days, as required by State Board regulations.
- 3. The District, by letter dated March 27, 1979, requested that the Board waive its 30-day time limit for appeal
- 4. The State Board intends to hold a hearing on another petition by the District concerning Step 2 design costs.
- 5. If the Board granted the District's request for a waiver, the issues regarding sizing of the sludge processing facilities and Step 2 design costs could be considered together at the same hearing.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the District's request for a waiver from the 30-day time limit for an appeal to the State Board is granted.
