STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 79-106

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT NO. 8 152 400-0 WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR A STUDY OF THE HEALTH IMPACTS OF DRY TOILETS AND GREYWATER SYSTEMS IN RURAL AREAS

WHEREAS:

- The State Board has contracted with the Department of Health Services (DOHS) to conduct a study of the health effects of dry toilets and greywater systems when used as a rural wastewater management technique.
- 2. The project has encountered delays due to an EPA modification of the scope of work, potential staff cutbacks within DOHS proposed in the F.Y. 1979-80 Budget, and requests by EPA, Region IX, for the inclusion of additional sites in the project.
- 3. The time extension of six months will allow the continuation of the field investigation work to provide an adequate data base for a thorough health evaluation of these units within rural areas of the State.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Executive Director is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute an amendment to Interagency Agreement No. 8 152 400-0 with the Department of Health Services to extend the term of the contract by six months at no additional cost to the State Board.
