RESOLUTION NO. 79-107

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF AMENDMENTS  
TO INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT NO. 7-108-41 WITH THE  
DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES AND STANDARD AGREEMENT  
NO. 7-210-41 WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, DAVIS,  
FOR A STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY OF USING IRRIGATION  
RETURN WATERS FOR AQUACULTURE

WHEREAS:

1. The State Board has contracted with the Department of Water Resources and the University of California, Davis, to conduct a research program to evaluate the feasibility of using irrigation return waters for aquaculture.
2. Due to a change in irrigation practices, a shortage of water for testing purposes limited some experiments. A time extension of four months will allow the project to complete studies interrupted by the shortage of water.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Executive Director is hereby authorized to execute amendments to Interagency Agreement No. 7-108-41 with the Department of Water Resources to extend the contract termination from February 23, 1980 to June 30, 1980 and to Standard Agreement No. 7-210-41 with the University of California, Davis, to extend the contract termination from March 3, 1980 to June 30, 1980, at no additional cost to the State Board.
