STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 80-5

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF INTERAGENCY AGREEMENTS WITH THE DEPARTMENTS OF FISH AND GAME AND WATER RESOURCES TO IMPLEMENT THE AMBIENT MONITORING PORTION OF THE EPA BASIC WATER MONITORING PROGRAM

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Board has primary responsibility for implementing the Federal Clean Water Act (the Act) in California on behalf of EPA.
- 2. Conduct of the Basic Water Monitoring Program (BWMP) is required under authority of Section 106 of the Act.
- 3. The Ambient Monitoring portion of the BWMP has been devised and specified by EPA in coordination with the State Board.
- 4. The Departments of Water Resources and Fish and Game have the necessary technical capabilities to perform the required monitoring and are willing to perform such work.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board's Executive Director is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute an interagency agreement with the Department of Fish and Game for an amount not to exceed \$9,000 for the period July 1, 1980, through June 30, 1981, and that the Executive Director is authorized to negotiate and execute an interagency agreement with the Department of Water Resources for an amount not to exceed \$23,000 for the period July 1, 1980, through June 30, 1981, for implementation of the Ambient Monitoring portion of the BWMP; provided, however, that the Executive Director shall not execute such agreements until funds shall have been reallocated to this program.
