- The State Water Resources Control Board is designated as the state water pollution control agency for all purposes stated in the Federal Clean Water Act.
- The State Water Resources Control Board staff has prepared a restoration priority list of lakes in California pursuant to the Federal Clean Water Act, Section 314.

- That the proposal list (Table 2) is hereby adopted as the National Clean Lakes Program priority list for California, pursuant to the Federal Clean Water Act, Section 314.
- 2. The Board's Executive Director is authorized to transmit the adopted National Clean Lakes Program Priority List For California to the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region IX.
