STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 80-57

APPROVING THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD, NORTH COAST REGION'S RESOLUTION NO. 80-12 ADOPTING THE REPORT ENTITLED "INVENTORY AND EVALUATION OF DAIRY FARMS IN MARIN AND SONOMA COUNTIES, PHASE I - SECTION I AND II" PREPARED BY THE MARIN AND SONOMA COUNTY RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICTS

WHEREAS:

- The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) has adopted "Minimum Guidelines for the Protection of Water Quality from Animal Wastes" and the Guidelines have been incorporated into the Water Quality Control Plan for the North Coast Basin.
- Dairy waste discharges in Marin and Sonoma Counties were identified as a significant problem requiring attention as a part of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region's (Regional Board), Phase I 208 planning effort.
- The State Board contracted with the Marin and Sonoma County Resource Conservation Districts (Districts) to conduct a study to inventory and evaluate dairy waste discharges in Marin and Sonoma Counties.
- The Districts have prepared and submitted a report entitled "Inventory and Evaluation of Dairy Farms in Marin and Sonoma Counties, Phase I - Section I and II".
- The report serves as the basis for formulating wastewater management plans by members of the dairy industry in Marin and Sonoma Counties.
- On May 22, 1980, the Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 80-12 approving the report.
- The report is being used by the Regional Board to evaluate dairy waste discharges and is also the basis for consideration in issuing waste discharge requirements.
- We have reviewed the report and find that it complies with the terms of the contract between the State Board, the Regional Board, and the Districts.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The State Board approves the report entitled "Inventory and Evaluation of Dairy Farms in Marin and Sonoma Counties, Phase I - Sections I and II".
