STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 80-66

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND THE DEPARTMENT OF MATER RESOURCES TO CONTINUE A PROGRAM OF GROUNDWATER MONITORING AND SPECIAL WATER QUALITY STUDIES.

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Board desires to continue a groundwater monitoring program and certain special studies through an agreement with a state agency.
- 2. The special studies are to include monitoring for toxic substances in certain Priority I groundwater basins, lake surveys, intensive bacteriological surveys and toxic monitoring in support of future toxic action plans.
- The Department of Water Resources has the staff and technical capability to provide the specified services and desires to provide such services to the State Board.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board's Executive Director be authorized to negotiate and execute an Interagency Agreement with the Department of Water Resources for ground-water monitoring and special water quality studies for an amount not to exceed \$85,000 in F.Y. 1980-81 Bond Fund monies and \$115,000 in F.Y. 1981-82 Bond Fund monies, subject to approval of the proposed F.Y. 1981-82 budget, for the period ending June 30, 1982.
