## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 80-67

ACCEPTING REASSIGNMENT OF APPLICATIONS 5645-B, 5646, AND 5647-A FROM U. S. WATER & POWER RESOURCES SERVICE\*

## WHEREAS:

- 1. On November 6, 1967 the State of California, California Water Commission assigned to the United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Reclamation the portion of Application 5645 pertaining to the Cosumnes River and its North Fork, Application 5646 in its entirety, and the portion of Application 5647 pertaining to Dry Creek and Sutter Creek, designated as Applications 5645-B, 5646, and 5647-A, respectively, for the operation of the proposed Cosumnes River Division of the Central Valley Project; and
- 2. The assignment instrument provided at page 5, Item (4)(a), that the assignments contained therein shall become finally and fully effective "Only if said proposed Cosumnes River Division is authorized by the Congress of the United States prior to January 1, 1969, or within such further time as the California Water Commission may approve. If such Congressional authorization is not given within the time prescribed by this condition, the California Water Commission shall thereupon have complete and unconditional custody of said Application 5646 and said portions of said Applications 5645 and 5647 and may assign or release the priority of the same in accordance with Part 2 of Division 6 of the California Water Code, and the assignee shall have no further interest in or rights under said application or portions of applications";
- 3. By Chapter 284, Statutes of 1967, effective December 1, 1967, authority over applications filed under the provisions of 10500 of the Water Code was transferred to the State Water Resources Control Board.
- 4. By Board orders dated March 6, 1969 and August 15, 1974, extensions were granted to January 1, 1974 and January 1, 1976, respectively.
- 5. The Service's\* request of December 18, 1975, for extension to January 1, 1982 has not been acted on.
- 6. On October 25, 1979 the Service\* advised that its current report contains no proposals for project authorization and requested that the Board receive back the three State assignments, Applications 5645-B, 5646, and 5647-A.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the California Water Resources Control Board hereby accepts the reassignment of Applications 5645-B, 5646 and 5647-A, to be held by the Board pursuant to Section 10504 of the Water Code.
