ASSIGNMENT OF STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD PERSONNEL TO THE CORPS OF ENGINEERS TO ASSIST IN MONITORING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES OF CLEAN WATER GRANT PROJECTS

WHEREAS:

- 1. Effective October 1, 1980 the State Water Resources Control Board (Board) returned to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) the responsibility for performance of various Step 3 construction grant related activities for certain Clean Water Grant projects.
- 2. EPA has entered into a contract with the Corps of Engineers (COE) to perform these activities.
- 3. In order to obtain skilled manpower on a short-term basis, the COE desires to execute Inter-Governmental Personnel Act (IPA) agreements, to contract with a number of Board employees.
- 4. The agreements will be for a term of one year with option to renew for an additional year.
- 5. Employees will remain on the payroll of the Board during the terms of the assignment and will work on the Division of Water Quality offices and organization. Total rebate of the employees' salaries and benefits will be made to the Board by the COE.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Executive Director of the State Water Resources Control Board be authorized to execute agreements under the Inter-Governmental Personnel Act for assignment of not to exceed 18 members of the Board's staff to the COE for a term of one year with option to renew to a maximum of four years.
