STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 81-4

CONTRACT TO TRANSFER CLEAN WATER GRANT FUNDS TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY TO FUND HOMITZ, ALLEN AND ASSOCIATES

WHEREAS:

- For the last three years the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has contracted with the firm of Homitz, Allen and Associates to assist Clean Water Grant Program grantees in the hiring of Minority Business Enterprises.
- 2. EPA's source of funds for the contract has been curtailed.
- 3. The contracted services has proven very effective.
- 4. The Board will execute a contract with a firm to provide such services.
- 5. Until such time as the contract is executed, interim funding will be necessary to fund EPA's contract.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Water Resources Control Board (Board) authorizes the Executive Director to enter into a contract with EPA. Such contract will provide for the transfer of \$200,000 of Clean Water Grant funds to EPA for the purpose of funding EPA's contract with Homitz, Allen and Associates. This authorization is subject to approval by appropriate State control agencies.
