STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD

RESOLUTION NO. 81-12

Directing the Executive Director to refer to the Attorney General the matter of unauthorized diversion of water by storage in a reservoir of John Ehlman on an unnamed stream tributary to Deer Creek in El Dorado County.

WHEREAS:

- 1. A complaint was received from the Cameron Estates Community Services District on June 5, 1980 expressing concern over the construction of an upstream dam.
- 2. A field observation was made on July 2, 1980. The reservoir was observed to be collecting and storing water without a valid water right permit or any other basis of right.
- 3. Mr. Ehlman was requested on three separate occasions, the last two being by certified mail, to file an application for a water right permit.
- An application has not been received.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Water Resources Control Board does direct and authorize the Executive Director to refer the matter of storage of water without a valid permit in the Ehlman reservoir to the Attorney General for appropriate action to require the release of water collected without a permit and to prevent any further storage of water. The Executive Director is authorized to defer referral to the Attorney General if a valid water right application for the project is filed and pursued diligently.
