ADOPTING A LIST OF STREAMS FOR INVESTIGATION BY THE INSTREAM BENEFICIAL USE PROTECTION PROJECT

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Instream Beneficial Use Protection Project (Instream Project) has been initiated to develop a program for improving the Board's ability to protect instream beneficial uses in selected streams.
- 2. A workplan has been approved which calls for staff investigation of three streams in 1981 during the pilot phase of the project.
- 3. The Board is seeking EPA 208 Phase IV funding for investigation of a fourth stream during 1982.
- 4. The Board has found it to be in the public interest to invite public participation in the selection of streams to be investigated by the Instream Project.
- 5. The Board has considered the names of streams and information submitted by the public and other agencies at the public hearing on February 29, 1980, and during the Workshop Meeting on February 4, 1981.
- 6. A list of streams has been selected which in the judgment of the Board, is appropriate for the purposes of the Instream Project.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

The following list of streams is approved for investigation by the Instream Project during 1981 and 1982.

Cottonwood Creek.
Lagunitas Creek, from
Peters Dam to Tomales
Bay.

Upper San Lorenzo River, above Zayante Creek. Lower San Lorenzo River and Zayante Creek
