RESOLUTION NO. 81-22

APPROVAL OF CENTRAL VALLEY REGION'S ABANDONED MINES  
WORKPLAN AS AN ALTERNATE FUNDING ALTERNATIVE FOR  
PHASE IV 208 FUNDS

WHEREAS:

1. The Abandoned Mines proposal is next eligible for funding on the EPA, Region IX, 208 Phase IV Priority List should funds be made available.
2. The Board received preliminary testimony on the workplan for this proposal on February 19, 1981.
3. The Board has reviewed the workplan and record of the Public Meeting.
4. The Board feels that funds for Penn Mine film should come from the Board's Public Participation Program.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board:

1. Approves the Abandoned Mines Workplans with the deletion of the Penn Mine film as an alternate proposal if previously allocated 208 Phase IV funds become available.
2. Authorizes the Executive Director to submit the workplan to EPA for approval.
3. Authorizes the Executive Director to submit an amended application for an EPA grant to fund this proposal upon notification by EPA that funds are available.
4. Authorizes the Executive Director to accept a grant for this project.
