STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 81-36

TRANSFERRING 208 AREAWIDE WASTE TREATMENT MANAGEMENT AGENCY DESIGNATION FROM SACRAMENTO REGIONAL AREA PLANNING COMMISSION (SRAPC) TO SACRAMENTO AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS (SACOG) AND EXPANDING THE AREA BOUNDARIES TO INCLUDE THE CITIES OF ROCKLIN AND LINCOLN

WHEREAS:

- 1. Section 208 of the Federal Clean Water Act (PL 92-217) specifies procedures for designating Areawide Waste Treatment Management Agencies within a state.
- 2. The State Water Resources Control Board designated the Sacramento Regional Area Planning Commission (SRAPC) as an Areawide Waste Treatment Management Agency pursuant to these regulations on April 15, 1976.
- 3. On January 15, 1981, SRAPC was succeeded by the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG).
- This succession was accomplished through a Joint Powers Agreement signed by all previous members of SRAPC.
- 5. The Cities of Rocklin and Lincoln also joined the new organization resulting in an area boundary change.
- 6. The State Board has given appropriate notice, held a public meeting on April 7, 1981, and did not hear any comments concerning this proposal.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

- 1. Approves the transfer of 208 Areawide Waste Treatment Management Agency designation from Sacramento Regional Area Planning Commission (SRAPC) to Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG).
- Approves an area boundary change to include the City of Rocklin and the City of Lincoln within the designated agency boundaries.
