## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 81-39

AQUATIC TOXICOLOGICAL CONSULTANT SERVICES FOR THE COOPERATIVE STRIPED BASS STUDY AND THE TOXIC SUBSTANCES CONTROL PROGRAM

## WHEREAS:

- Expertise in the areas of aquatic toxicology, oceanography, and water pollution chemistry is continuously needed for technical guidance for the interagency Cooperative Striped Bass Study.
- Such expertise has been and will continue to be of beneficial use to the State Board's Toxic Substances Control Program, Regional Boards, and Bay-Delta Program.
- 3. The services provided by the Foundation for Ocean Research are essential for successfully completing and utilizing the results from the Cooperative Striped Bass Study.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Water Resources Control Board's Executive Officer be authorized to negotiate and execute a standard agreement in an amount not to exceed \$60,000 for 18 months for aquatic toxicological consultant services necessary for the Board's Toxic Substances Control Program and Cooperative Striped Bass Study.
