STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 81-41

STATE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM GRANT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES FOR WATER CONSERVATION ACTIVITIES

WHEREAS,

- 1. On July 17, 1980 the Board adopted a Tentative Project Priority List for the State Assistance Program. This list provides for an allocation of up to \$4 million to the Department of Water Resources (DWR) for unspecified Water Conservation Projects to be negotiated between the Board and the Director of DWR.
- 2. The Board and DWR have negotiated an agreement to join efforts towards implementing water conservation and reclamation programs throughout the State.
- 3. DWR has submitted for Board approval work plans for the five remaining projects under the \$4 million allocation. These work plans total \$1,672,000.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the Board intends to grant up to \$4 million to DWR as work plans are approved by the Board.
- 2. That the Board approves Work Plans #3 through #7, totaling \$1,672,000 in grant funds.
