STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 81-42

Authorizing the Executive Director to Negotiate and Execute Contract for the Preparation of Guidance Manuals on the use of Reclaimed Municipal Wastewater in Irrigated Agriculture.

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Board's basic goal of the Water Reclamation/Conservation Program is to take all reasonable actions to conserve water supplies and to reuse wastewater to the maximum extent feasible.
- 2. The State Board, with the assistance of the University of California Cooperative Extension, contracted with Boyle Engineering Corporation to collect and evaluate data on the existing agricultural irrigation sites in California using reclaimed wastewater. The final report was published in February 1981.
- 3. The project plan involves the preparation of two guidance manuals on the use of reclaimed wastewater in irrigated agriculture. The manuals will be prepared by a committee of consultant of the University of California.
- 4. The total cost for this contract is \$55,000.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Executive Director is authorized to negotiate and execute contract with the Regents of the University of California for the preparation of two guidance manuals in a total amount not to exceed \$55,000.
