RESOLUTION NO. 81-61

APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS TO THE CENTRAL VALLEY REGION'S  
PHASE II 208 TULARE LAKE GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS,

1. The State Water Resources Control Board is responsible for conducting 208 planning under the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, and
2. The State Board and EPA approved a Phase II 208 workplan for the Tulare Lake Groundwater Management Program in the Central Valley Region, and
3. This program consisted of two projects:
  - Buena Vista project to study management of perched saline groundwaters
  - Westside project to study groundwater impacts from oil field and agricultural wastewater disposal practices.
4. The Buena Vista Resource Conservation District does not wish to participate in this program.
5. The Central Valley Regional Board staff have proposed to transfer the Buena Vista funds to conduct additional studies in the Westside area and submitted a revised workplan to include the additional study tasks.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The State Board approves the proposed amendments to the Central Valley Regional Board's Phase II 208 Tulare Lake Groundwater Management program as follows:
  - Cancel the Buena Vista project
  - Approve the revised workplan for the Westside project
  - Transfer the Buena Vista funding allotment to the Westside project.
2. Staff is directed to transmit these revisions to EPA and request their approval of these changes.
