RESOLUTION NO. 81-71

AMENDMENTS TO THE LAKE TAHOE PHASE IV 208 WORKPLAN

WHEREAS:

1. The State Water Resources Control Board is responsible for administration of the 208 planning program in California, and
2. The State Board approved a Phase IV 208 workplan for Lahontan Region with the understanding that, if the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA) was reinstated as the designated Areawide Waste Treatment Management Planning Agency for the Tahoe Basin, an alternative TRPA workplan would be funded instead, and
3. The State Board conditionally reinstated TRPA's designation as an Areawide Water Quality Management Planning Agency on June 18, 1981, and
4. TRPA has proposed substantial changes to its Phase IV 208 program, and
5. The State Board has reviewed and considered comments pertaining to these proposed amendments at its meeting held on July 16, 1981, and
6. The State Board has reviewed the staff reports and concurs with the changes to the Phase IV workplan recommended therein.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

1. Recommends that EPA approve the revised TRPA Phase IV workplan, and directs the Executive Director to transmit this recommendation to EPA, and,
2. Reaffirms the State Board's intention to match the Lahontan Regional Board's portion of the work program with \$67,000 of Clean Water Bond Funds as approved by State Water Resources Control Board Resolution No. 81-3 on January 22, 1981.
