STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 82-3

APPROVING REVISIONS TO THE PHASE II 208 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION WORKPLAN AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO APPROVE EXPENDITURES OF FUNDS FOR SPECIFIC PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROJECTS TO BE CONDUCTED IN THE 208 NONDESIGNATED AREA

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Environmental Protection Agency granted funds to the State Water Resources Control Board specifically for public participation activities in support of Phase II 208 programs in the 208 non-designated areas.
- 2. Funds are to be expended on public participation projects with the objectives of promoting an understanding of specific nonpoint source pollution problems and promoting implementation of Best Management Practices to correct these problems.
- 3. The State Water Resources Control Board directed staff to revise the public participation workplan that was previously submitted to the Board for approval.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

- 1. Approves the revised Phase II 208 Public Participation Workplan.
- Authorizes the Executive Director to approve expenditures of funds for specific public participation projects on a projectby-project basis.
