STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION 82-6

APPROVING THE FINAL PRODUCT OF A PHASE II 208 CONTRACT WITH HIGH SIERRA RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT

WHEREAS:

- The State Water Resources Control Board is responsible for conducting Section 208 planning in accordance with the Federal Water Pollution Control Act of 1972 and subsequent amendments, and
- 2. The Board approved a workplan for Erosion and Sediment Control Studies to be conducted by High Sierra Resource Conservation District as a part of the County Studies Element of the Central Valley Regional Board's Phase II 208 work program, and
- The Board has contracted with High Sierra Resource Conservation District
 to prepare a handbook of management practices to control erosion and
 sedimentation problems in Nevada, Sierra, Placer and El Dorado Counties, and
- 4. The High Sierra Resource Conservation District has prepared this handbook entitled: "Erosion and Sediment Control Guidelines for Developing Areas of the Sierras" and
- 5. The handbook contains the information required in the contract.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board

- 1. Accepts the High Sierra Resource Conservation District "Erosion and Sediment Control Guidelines for Developing Areas of the Sierras" as completion of their contract with the Board, and
- 2. Authorizes payment of the final invoice, and
- 3. Directs the Executive Director to transmit a copy of the handbook to EPA for their review and approval.
