RESOLUTION 82-6

APPROVING THE FINAL PRODUCT OF A PHASE II 208
CONTRACT WITH HIGH SIERRA RESOURCE CONSERVATION
DISTRICT

WHEREAS:

1. The State Water Resources Control Board is responsible for conducting Section 208 planning in accordance with the Federal Water Pollution Control Act of 1972 and subsequent amendments, and
2. The Board approved a workplan for Erosion and Sediment Control Studies to be conducted by High Sierra Resource Conservation District as a part of the County Studies Element of the Central Valley Regional Board's Phase II 208 work program, and
3. The Board has contracted with High Sierra Resource Conservation District to prepare a handbook of management practices to control erosion and sedimentation problems in Nevada, Sierra, Placer and El Dorado Counties, and
4. The High Sierra Resource Conservation District has prepared this handbook entitled: "Erosion and Sediment Control Guidelines for Developing Areas of the Sierras" and
5. The handbook contains the information required in the contract.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board

1. Accepts the High Sierra Resource Conservation District "Erosion and Sediment Control Guidelines for Developing Areas of the Sierras" as completion of their contract with the Board, and
2. Authorizes payment of the final invoice, and
3. Directs the Executive Director to transmit a copy of the handbook to EPA for their review and approval.
