RESOLUTION NO. 82-14

REQUEST TO RESCHEDULE PROJECTS FOR THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES TO THE FUNDABLE PORTION OF THE FY 1981 PRIORITY LIST

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Board adopted the FY 1981 Priority List on September 18, 1980.
- 2. The Environmental Protection Agency has issued a class deviation allowing the states to continue use of their FY 1981 Priority Lists until October 1, 1982, for the purpose of issuing grants.
- 3. The City of Los Angeles, citing cash flow problems, has requested \$46.6 million in grant funds for the Hyperion Energy Recovery System (HERS) segments which must proceed to construction prior to October 1, 1982, if the City is to meet its Consent Decree schedule.
- 4. The HERS segments shown in Exhibit A were scheduled for funding in FY 1982 on the FY 1981 List and would have been on the fundable portion of the FY 1982 List, had it been implemented.
- 5. Requests were received from grantees for other changes to the FY 1981 List at a time when the fundable portion of the FY 1981 List exceeds the expected federal funding.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Board amend the FY 1981 Priority List by rescheduling the HERS segments as shown in Exhibit A to the fundable portion of the FY 1981 List.
- 2. The Board condition each segment placed on the fundable portion of the FY 1981 List such that award of grant assistance will not be given until the Appeals Court decision is resolved.
- 3. The Board will consider no further changes to the FY 1981 List. All requested revisions will be considered for addition to the FY 1983 Priority List to be adopted by the Board on August 19, 1982.
