# STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 82-16

## APPROVING THE FINAL PRODUCT OF A PHASE II 208 CONTRACT WITH SIERRA COUNTY

## WHEREAS:

- The State Water Resources Control Board is responsible for the Statewide Section 208 planning program in accordance with the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, and
- 2. The Board approved a workplan for Erosion and Sediment Control Studies to be conducted by Sierra County as a part of the County Studies Element of the Central Valley Regional Board's Phase II 208 work program, and
- 3. The Board contracted with Sierra County to:
  - a) Inventory drainage and erosion problems arising from various land use activities,
  - b) Evaluate the effectiveness of the County's existing erosion control system,
  - c) Evaluate alternative practices and develop an action plan for implementation.
- 4. Sierra County prepared a report entitled "208 Erosion Control Study for Sierra County".
- 5. The State Board has reviewed the report and finds that the report satisfies the contract objectives.

#### THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

## That the State Board:

- Approves Sierra County's final report titled "208 Erosion Control Study for Sierra County" as completion of their 208 contract.
- 2. Certifies the Sierra County report as an element of the Statewide 208 Plan.
- 3. Directs the Executive Director to transmit a copy of the report to EPA for review and approval.
- Directs staff to develop proposals for redirection of the remaining \$4,940.00 within the State's 208 Program.
