RESOLUTION NO. 82-16

APPROVING THE FINAL PRODUCT OF A PHASE II 208
CONTRACT WITH SIERRA COUNTY

WHEREAS:

1. The State Water Resources Control Board is responsible for the Statewide Section 208 planning program in accordance with the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, and
2. The Board approved a workplan for Erosion and Sediment Control Studies to be conducted by Sierra County as a part of the County Studies Element of the Central Valley Regional Board's Phase II 208 work program, and
3. The Board contracted with Sierra County to:
 - a) Inventory drainage and erosion problems arising from various land use activities,
 - b) Evaluate the effectiveness of the County's existing erosion control system,
 - c) Evaluate alternative practices and develop an action plan for implementation.
4. Sierra County prepared a report entitled "208 Erosion Control Study for Sierra County".
5. The State Board has reviewed the report and finds that the report satisfies the contract objectives.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

1. Approves Sierra County's final report titled "208 Erosion Control Study for Sierra County" as completion of their 208 contract.
2. Certifies the Sierra County report as an element of the Statewide 208 Plan.
3. Directs the Executive Director to transmit a copy of the report to EPA for review and approval.
4. Directs staff to develop proposals for redirection of the remaining \$4,940.00 within the State's 208 Program.
