STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 82-17

APPROVING THE FINAL REPORT, ASSESSMENT OF CUMULATIVE IMPACTS OF INDIVIDUAL WASTE TREATMENT AND DISPOSAL SYSTEMS

WHEREAS

- 1. The State Water Resources Control Board is responsible for conducting Section 208 planning in accordance with the Federal Water Pollution Control Act of 1972 and subsequent amendments, and
- 2. The North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board's Phase II 208
 Workplan calls for Development of Best Management Practices for Individual
 Waste Treatment Disposal and
- 3. The State Board entered into a contract on behalf of the Regional Board with the firm of Ramlit Associates for the purpose of providing an assessment methodology for evaluating the cumulative water quality impacts which result from on-site wastewater disposal, and
- 4. Ramlit Associates submitted a Final Report, <u>Assessment of Cumulative Impacts</u> of Individual Waste Treatment and Disposal Systems in February 1982, and
- 5. The North Coast Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 82-2 approving the Final Report, and found it to be a complete and comprehensive study of the subject, and
- 6. The State Board has reviewed the Final Report and finds that it fulfills the contract objectives and has application not only locally, but throughout the State of California.
- 7. The North Coast Regional Board will use information contained in this report to revise the Regional Board's Individual Waste Disposal Policy and amend its Basin Plan.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

- 1. Accepts the Final Report, <u>Assessment of Cumulative Impacts of Individual Waste Treatment and Disposal Systems</u>, submitted by Ramlit Associates as completion of their contract with the Regional Board, and
- 2. Authorizes payment of the final invoice, and
- 3. Directs the Executive Director to transmit a copy of the Final Report to EPA for their review and approval.
- 4. Directs staff to transmit copies of the Final Report to the other Regional Boards.
