STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD Resolution No. 82-22

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES FOR PRIMARY NETWORK/BWMP MONITORING THROUGH JUNE 1983

WHEREAS:

- The State Board requires baseline and trend water quality data at key locations statewide to assist in defining water quality problems and issues and in providing water quality assessments to the Regional Boards.
- The Department of Water Resources operates the State Board's Primary water quality monitoring network on a long-term basis, renewed annually.
- The State Board operates, through the Department of Water Resources, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Basic Water Monitoring Program using 106 Grant monies.
- 4. The Department of Water Resources has the staff and technical capability to provide the specified services and desires to continue to provide such services to the State Board in Fiscal Year 1982-83.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board authorize the Executive Director to negotiate and execute an Interagency Agreement with the Department of Water Resources for operation of the Primary Network and Basic Water Monitoring Program through June 30, 1983, in an amount not to exceed \$190,000 in F.Y. 82-83 Bond Fund and \$41,000 in Federal 106 Grant monies, subject to availability of funds.
