APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE OF
A GRANT AMENDMENT FROM THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA)
TO PROVIDE SERVICES FOR TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO MINORITY AND WOMEN OWNED
BUSINESSES (MBE/WBE)

WHEREAS:

- 1. For the past two years, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has provided a Clean Water Act (201) grant to the Board for the purpose of contracting with a firm to assist Clean Water Grant Program grantees in the hiring of Minority and Women Owned Businesses.
- The Board has contracted for these services and the funding for the contract will be exhausted on March 31, 1984.
- 3. The contracted services have proven very effective.
- 4. It is desirable to advertise and execute a new contract for MBE and WBE services.
- 5. EPA can make additional Clean Water Act (201) funds available to the State for contracting for such services.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board authorize the Executive Director to submit an application for and accept a Clean Water Act grant amendment of approximately \$150,000 for providing MBE/WBE services.
