STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 84- 28

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME FOR CONTINUED OPERATION OF THE TOXICS SUBSTANCES MONITORING PROGRAM IN FY 1984-85

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Board has the responsibility to monitor the occurrence of toxic substances in the waters of the State.
- 2. The State Board's Toxic Substances Monitoring Program is providing valuable information on the occurrence of toxic substances in the State's surface fresh waters.
- 3. It is desirable that this Program be continued, consistent with the State Board's emphasis on the control of toxic substances.
- 4. The Department of Fish and Game has qualified personnel, facilities, and experience to continue operation of this Program.
- 5. The U. S. Environmental Protection Agency has requested that the State Board perform the California portion of the national dioxin survey and intends to reimburse the State Board for the cost of this survey.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorize the Executive Director to negotiate and execute an interagency agreement with the Department of Fish and Game for continued operation of the Toxic Substances Monitoring Program through June 30, 1985, in an amount not to exceed \$210,000 in FY 1984-85 Bond fund monies, and \$20,000 in EPA funds, subject to approval of the FY 1984-85 budget, and to accept a grant or administrative transfer of monies from the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency to perform the freshwater portion of the national dioxin survey in California.
