STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 84-31

APPROVAL OF AN AMENDMENT OF THE COMPREHENSIVE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR THE SAN DIEGO BASIN TO ALLOW MODIFICATIONS TO GROUND WATER QUALITY OBJECTIVES FOR THE SAN ELIJO HYDROGRAPHIC SUBAREA

WHEREAS:

- On March 17, 1975, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region, (Regional Board) acting in accord with Section 13244 of the California Water Code, adopted the Comprehensive Water Quality Control Plan for the San Diego Region (basin plan).
- 2. Division 7 of the California Water Code specifies that basin plans will be periodically reviewed and may be revised.
- The Regional Board held public hearings on August 29, 1983 and October 3, 1983 for the purpose of receiving testimony on a proposed amendment to the basin plan.
- 4. Regional Board staff prepared documents and followed appropriate procedures to satisfy the environmental documentation requirements of both the California Environmental Quality Act, the Public Resources Code Section 21080.5, and the Federal Clean Water Act.
- 5. The proposed basin plan amendment and environmental documents were widely circulated for review.
- 6. The Regional Board has determined that the proposed basin plan amendment will not have a significant effect on the environment as long as the proposed mitigation measures are implemented.
- 7. On October 3, 1983, based on the facts and findings after the public hearing, the Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 83-27 amending Chapters 2 and 4 of the basin plan as modified.
- 8. The Regional Board has determined that the proposed amendment is consistent with the non-degradation policy.
- 9. On January 26, 1984, the Regional Board submitted a request to the State Board for consideration of approval for the basin plan amendment.
- 10. The Regional Board has followed appropriate procedures to satisfy all relevant State and Federal statutes.
- Basin plan amendments do not become effective until approved by the State Board.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board approve the amendment to the basin plan incorporating revisions to portions of Chapters 2 and 4 as adopted by Regional Board Resolution No. 83-27.
