STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 84- 35

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR LABORATORY ANALYTICAL SERVICES FOR THE REGIONAL BOARDS IN FY 1984-85

WHEREAS:

- The Regional Boards have a continuing need for laboratory analyses of water quality samples taken as part of their regulatory programs.
- 2. The Regional Boards' use of water quality sampling and analysis is an important part of the State Board's regulatory program.
- The Department of Health Services, which has provided such services since 1976, is capable of and amenable to providing such services in FY 1984-85.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorize the Executive Director to negotiate and execute an Interagency Agreement with the Department of Health Services for an amount not to exceed \$199,000 in FY 1984-85 General Fund monies and \$10,000 in 205(j) Grant monies for Regional Board and State Board laboratory analytical services through June 30, 1985, subject to availability of funds.
