# STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 84-37

# ADOPTING A NEW ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES MANUAL

#### WHEREAS:

- 1. Recent audits by the Legislative Analyst and the Auditor General's Office have recommended that the State Board update and utilize consistent administrative procedures.
- 2. The State Board developed a Procedures Manual, dated March 1975, governing internal procedures of the State and Regional Boards.
- 3. In order to improve its regulatory program, the State Board has prepared a revised Administrative Procedures Manual.
- 4. The revised manual contains updated procedures for issuing waste discharge requirements, guidance on fee collection, and procedures for enforcement actions.
- 5. Adoption of the revised Administrative Procedures Manual constitutes procedure making and, as such, is not a "project" for purposes of the California Environmental Quality Act, Public Resources Code §§ 21000 et seq. 14 C.A.C. § 15378(b)(3).

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED

- 1. That the State Board approves the revised Administrative Procedures Manual.
- That all prior procedures manuals are rescinded.
- That the Executive Director is authorized to correct typographical errors, to make minor modifications in the manual, and to add an Appendix to the manual with appropriate formats.
- 4. That all other changes or amendments to the manual will be made by the State Board.
