## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 84-42

ADOPTING AN UPDATED 1984 CLEAN LAKES PROGRAM PRIORITY LIST FOR CALIFORNIA AND AUTHORIZING TRANSMITTAL TO THE U. S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

## WHEREAS:

- The State Water Resources Control Board is designated as the state water pollution control agency for all purposes stated in the Federal Clean Water Act.
- 2. Surveys of persons interested in California lakes, including the Clean Lake Program, were conducted in 1979 and again in 1984, asking for nominations to the Clean Lakes Priority List.
- 3. As a result of these surveys, the State Water Resources Control Board's staff have prepared a 1984 update of the priority list of candidate California lakes for restoration and enhancement of beneficial uses pursuant to the Federal Clean Water Act, Section 314.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the updated list (attached) is hereby adopted as the National Clean Lakes Program Priority List for California, pursuant to the Federal Clean Water Act, Section 314.
- 2. That the Board's Executive Director is authorized to transmit the adopted National Clean Lakes Program Priority List for California to the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region 9.
