STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 84-59

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO ACCEPT A SECTION 104(g)(1) GRANT FROM THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA) FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING ACTIVITIES OF THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL INSTITUTE

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Board is concerned with the problems impeding the effective operation of small publicly owned treatment works (POTW).
- 2. The State Board wishes to continue operator training activities of the Water Quality Control Institute. Section 104(g) (1) of the Clean Water Act provides funding for the purpose of training personnel to operate and maintain existing and future treatment works.
- 3. Curricula at the Water Quality Institute needs updating.
- 4. A grant application has been submitted to the Environmental Protection Agency for \$118,000.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board authorize the Executive Director to accept a Section 104(g)(1) grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency when it is offered.
