STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 84-63

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF A STANDARD AGREEMENT FOR HYDROGEOLOGIC AND QUALITY CONTROL INVESTIGATION IN THE VICINITY OF THE AEROJET SITE, RANCHO CORDOVA, CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS:

- 1. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region, (Regional Board) has discovered widespread ground water contamination in eastern Sacramento County on and near land owned by the Aerojet-General Corporation.
- 2. The Regional Board has issued Cleanup and Abatement Orders to Aerojet-General Corporation and has referred the case to the Attorney General for civil monetary remedies.
- 3. The Regional Board has identified and monitored existing wells in the area and collected a considerable amount of data regarding the quality of the ground waters in eastern Sacramento County.
- 4. The Regional Board has found that the data collected from existing contaminated wells in eastern Sacramento County is insufficient to document the horizontal and vertical extent of such ground water pollution; well logs for most of the existing polluted wells do not exist and do not fully document site hydrogeology; and existing sampling procedures and equipment must be reviewed for court worthiness, it is necessary to investigate the as-built construction of the polluted wells and conduct a validity study on sampling procedures and equipment.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorize the Executive Director to negotiate and execute a Standard Agreement for a hydrogeologic and quality control investigation in an amount not to exceed \$314,000, fiscal year funds, for a period of two years.
