"GLYPHOSATE USE IN FORESTRY (ROUNDUP) AND

WHEREAS:

- Toxics Special Project staff has prepared a report on glyphosate use in aquatic and silvicultural weed control;
- 2. The report incorporates peer review comments from scientists recognized in the fields of environmental chemistry and toxicology, as well as technical comments from scientists from other state and federal agencies;
- 3. The major findings of this report are summarized in the agenda item fact sheet:
- 4. Staff has developed several recommendations for mitigating the impacts of glyphosate on beneficial uses of water.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the State Board accept the report entitled "Glyphosate Use In Forestry (ROUNDUP) and Aquatic Weed Control (RODEO): A Water Quality Assessment."
- 2. That staff be instructed to transmit the specific recommendations in the report to appropriate state and federal agencies and pesticide registrants.
- 3. That staff be instructed to prepare a supplemental report on glyphosate and its formulated products (ROUNDUP and RODEO) which includes review of all relevant information on environmental fate, monitoring, and toxicity.
